

Examples of possible scenarios

- 1. One group has full time <u>exclusive</u> use of the main room. 3 groups have one day per week. 2 groups have one evening per week. Men's Shed cover balance.
- 2. One group has full time **non-exclusive** use of the main room. One group has full time **non-exclusive** use of one class room. 2 groups have one day per week. 2 groups have one evening per week. Men's Shed cover balance.
- 3. The Men's Shed have exclusive use of the whole building for the first year and control costs accordingly.

Based on a weekly running cost of approx. £330 per week

Example 1: Total income from other groups approx. £342

Example 3: A shoe string approach taken, we would have total control of costs, doing our own cleaning and saving energy where possible Insurance £40.00, Rent £2. Electric £10. Gas £40. Maintenance £10 A total of £102 per week (what we pay in rent now)
