- To ensure that the information held on pupils is current and correct.

- Scottish Government for census purposes.
- Partner agencies (ie: NHS) where applicable.
- Other services available within Education & Children's Service were required.

The retention period for the data is:

We will keep this information for a period of 5 years from the maximum school leaving age of your child, as required to by The Pupils' Educational Records (Scotland) Regulations 2003, unless we have a legal responsibility to keep the information for a longer period of time.

Please note that you have the following rights:

- to withdraw consent at any time, where the Legal Basis specified above is Consent;
- to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (after raising the issue with the Data Protection Officer first);
- to request access to your personal data;
- to object, where the legal basis specified above is:
  - (i) Performance of a Public Task; or
  - (ii) Legitimate Interests.
- to data portability, where the legal basis specified above is:
  - (i) Consent; or
  - (ii) Performance of a Contract;
- to request rectification or erasure of your personal data, as so far as the legislation permits.
