Your information is being collected to use for the following purposes:

- To obtain an application for Mid-Market Housing Provision.
 - o To determine whether you are eligible for Mid-Market Housing.
 - o To determine your housing needs and priority.
 - o To assist and match people to suitable properties.
 - o To check whether previous tenancies were conducted satisfactorily.
 - o To conduct a credit check (if applicable).
- To, if applicable, manage any tenancy that you may be offered.
 - o To provide support to enable you to keep your Mid-Market house, if appropriate.
 - To allow Aberdeenshire Council to collect rent and other payments from you, if and when they become due.
 - o Repairs and maintenance.
 - o Refurbishment.
 - Tenancy management.
 - o Deposit management.

The Council will not be able to perform its statutory duties under the Housing (Scotland) Act 2006, and the Private Housing (Tenancies) (Scotland) Act 2016 meaning the tenancy could not be sustained.

The Council will not be able to consider your application for a mid-market rental property.





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Your information will be shared with the following recipients or categories of recipient:

At Application:

On receipt of a valid application, personal data will be shared with Create Homes for the creation of a tenancy. We would also share information with the following third parties and for the following purposes:

- An approved credit reference site to undertake an appropriate credit search.
- Former/current landlords to undertake appropriate reference checks.

On the notification of a mid-market Housing tenancy with Create Homes (if applicable):

To ensure effective management of your tenancy we may share your information with a number of agencies or external partners depending on the circumstances. These might include: -

- Rent collection and other outstanding payments in the event of you falling into arrears or owing Housing monies for any reason we would take appropriate action to recover the debt which may require sharing information with various external agencies including HM Revenue and Customs, National Fraud Initiative, Sheriff Officers and Debt Collection Agencies and Department of Work Pensions;
- Repairs information relating to addresses and occupancy will be shared with our subcontractors and consultants engaged to assess tenant satisfaction with repairs;
- Deposit- will be shared with a tenancy deposit administrator in accordance with legislative requirement
- Refurbishments information relating to addresses and occupancy will be shared with our contractors:
- O/T assessments information relating to addresses and occupancy will be shared with our contractors
- Tenancy Management depending on the issues we may share information with our Community Safety Partners including Police, NHS etc.
- Power supplier companies for provision of gas and electricity mains supply
