
TRANSPORT (SCOTLAND) ACT 2019

THE ABERDEENSHIRE COUNCIL (PAVEMENT PARKING EXEMPTION – BANFF AND
BUCHAN) ORDER, 2023

Aberdeenshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under Section 51 of the Transport (Scotland) Act 2019, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following order:-

1. This order may be cited as “The Aberdeenshire Council (Pavement Parking Exemption – Banff and Buchan) Order, 2023”, and shall come into operation on 11 December 2023.
2. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this order and marked on the plan annexed hereto, shall hereby be exempt from the pavement parking prohibition detailed in Section 50 of the Transport (Scotland) Act 2019.
