Public service authority: **Aberdeenshire Council (“the Council”)**

The Council **agrees** to Stonehaven & District Community Council’s request to participate in an outcome improvement process.

In the request, Stonehaven & District Community Council stated outcomes that they want to improve are *“In relation to the implementation of Aberdeenshire HSCP mental health strategy, improve connectivity/integration between delivery partners and service users. Improve transition, access, and signposting for users and families/carers. Improve support available to members of the community living with long-term mental health conditions. Improve mental health and wellbeing within the local community.”*

The Council would like to co-opt members, or contacts, of Stonehaven & District Community Council on to project groups looking at strategic delivery themes directly connected to the outcomes identified to involve Stonehaven & District in an Outcome Improvement process.

An outcome improvement process has been initiated and will continued in line with requirements of section 28 of the Community Empowerment Act. The length of the outcome improvement process will be agreed with members or contacts of the community participation body.

In terms of section 26(3) of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015, any written representations on the above proposal may be made by the community participation body no later than 17 July 2019.
