






Grassland areas






Cropping areas













Rainfall








2018 Mean Temperature





Mean temperatures (1981-2010) anomalies for 2018



2018 Rainfall








2018 Sunshine

What does this mean for arable farmers?




- Some farms recording record yields of wheat
