The school is using the Park Smart programme to help keep children, parents/carers and school staff safe when they come and go from the school. Every child and adult can help to make us all safer.

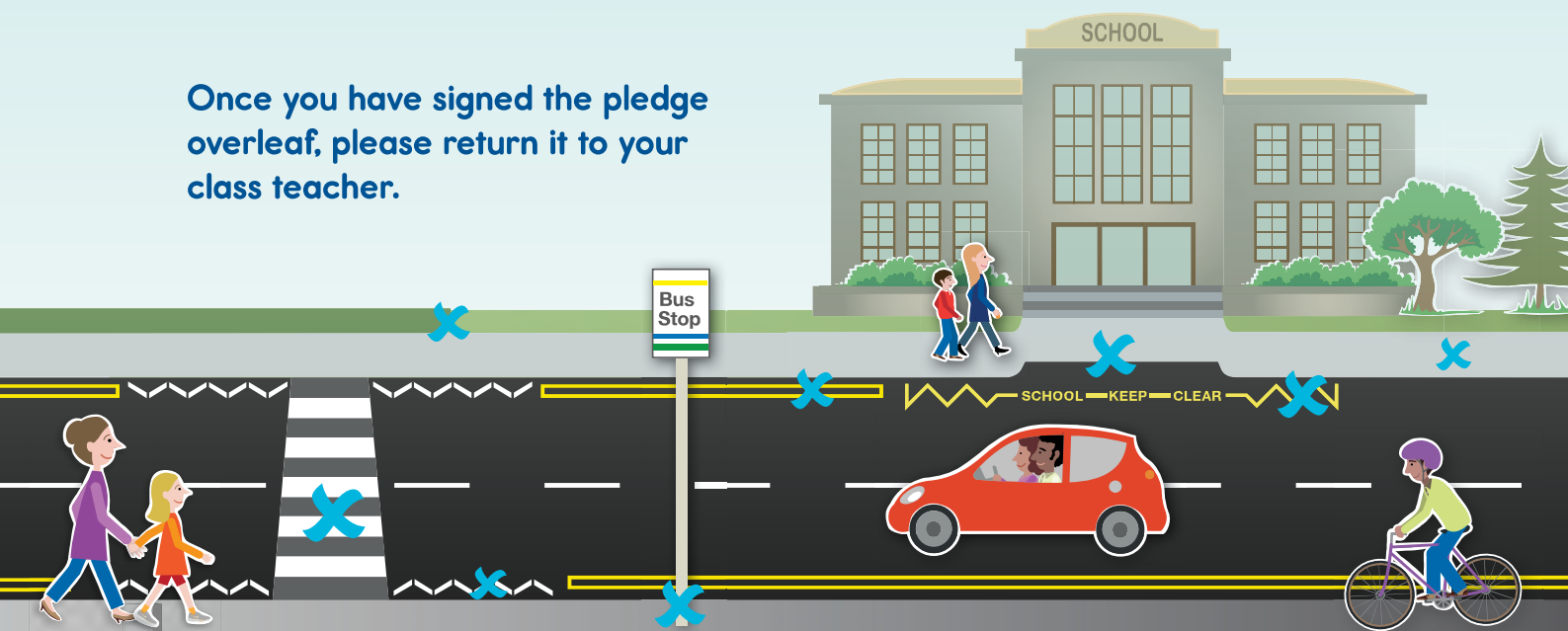

It asks you to remind whoever brings you to and from school to always let you walk, scoot or cycle if you can, or if you do come by car to park sensibly and safely.

Primary School Park Smart Pupil Pledge

1. If I am sometimes or always driven to and from school I will ask if I can sometimes walk, scoot or cycle
2. If I am driven to or from school, I will ask the driver to park a little way away from the school and walk the last part of the journey, so that our car doesn't cause congestion around the school
3. If I am driven to or from school, I will ask the driver to always park or wait in sensible locations, and never:
 - a. On school zig zag markings
 - b. On double yellow lines
 - c. On pavements
 - d. On corners where it would make it difficult for other drivers to see
 - e. Blocking people's driveways or other places.
