Why Park Smart?

If you drive to the school, even occasionally:

1. Consider whether you need to drive before making the journey to school by car and use alternatives if you can.

3. If you must drive close to the school, make the time to park in a sensible and safe location.

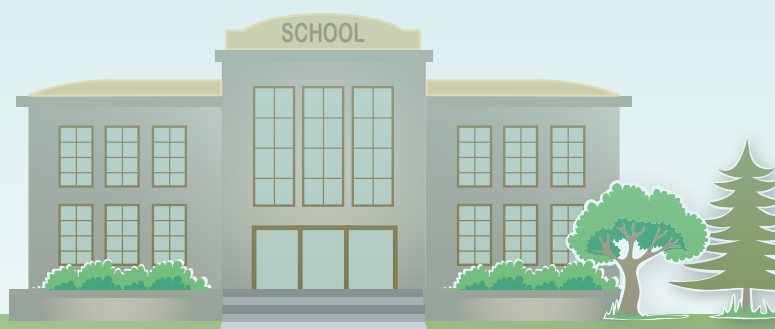
