Why Park Smart?

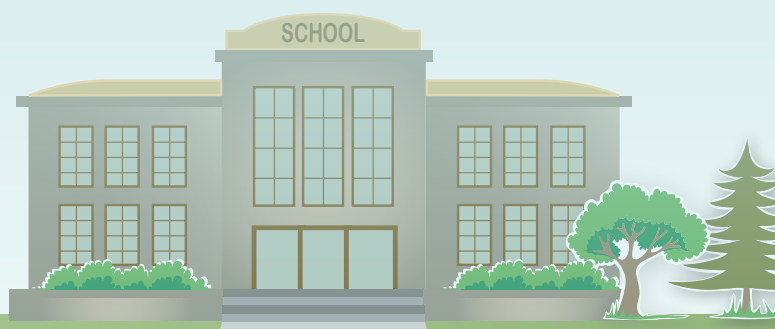
Children are at particular risk from traffic and badly parked cars as they:
