### Site updates

Since our last newsletter in June, we have continued making progress on the project and are happy to report the completion date remains on schedule.

### Building Works

Works associated with the main building structure are now nearing completion and the form of the main school and community facility is now clearly visible.

We have already commenced with roofing, external walls and window installation. Over the coming months, as the building starts to be enclosed, we will begin the internal fit out works.

Work on the community campus pools is well underway, and the foundations and ground floor slab of the St Andrews Building have started.

### Workforce

Currently we have an average on site workforce of 80 colleagues. This is scheduled to increase during the next three months. Material deliveries to the site will also increase. These processes will be diligently managed by the Robertson site team to ensure there is no increased community impact from our ongoing operations.

## School engagement

During the past few months, we have welcomed over 100 pupils from local primary schools to the site. Some pupils have been from our Robertson Reporter programme where kids from the feeder schools visit on a regular basis to learn about the different stages of the project. The pupils then report back to their school on the progress of their new community campus.

## Inverurie Academy

We continue to work closely with Inverurie Academy to offer a variety of engaging activities for pupils.

Our Trade Route programme is in full swing, with a variety of practical trade activities planned throughout the next few months. As we head into January 2019, we will be inviting the students on site again to gain valuable work experience in construction.

At the end of August, Scotland's Deputy First Minister John Swinney visited the Inverurie Community Campus site to see how the project was progressing. While in the area, he met pupils and staff of the current school to learn more about the wider community and the educational benefits the new facility will have on Inverurie and surrounding areas.

## Recycling

Over 99% of our total waste, which would previously have gone to landfill, has been redirected to be either reused or recycled.



We have registered with the Considerate Constructors Scheme, and you will see signage displayed around our site perimeter.

The aim of the scheme is to improve the image of construction; ensuring we minimise negative impact and integrate into the community during our time here.
