### Victoria Park

We have completed the car park at Victoria Park with the school bus drop-off now in operation. This has allowed us to relocate to a new site office and take possession of the whole site to continue with the main works. We would like to take this opportunity to thank all nearby residents for their patience and understanding whilst the works to Victoria Park were completed.

### Foundation works/steel frame

The new campus foundation works continue with excavation and formation underway for the four swimming pools. The foundations will be complete later this month, with work on the structural steel starting thereafter. Please note that there will be an increase in site traffic during this period for deliveries. The restricted delivery times will continue to apply to the project during school term time.

### Jackson Street drainage works

Drainage works on Jackson Street will take place week commencing 9th July until 17th August with staged road closures on Jackson Street, and traffic management on the High Street to allow construction of the main drain connection.

Residents and businesses directly affected by the works will be invited to an open evening

with Robertson to allow us to run them through the planned works, agreements made with the local authority and emergency services to ensure minimal disruption to all affected.

We are proposing w/c 18th June for this meeting. Time and venue will be confirmed and communicated as soon as possible.

### Contractor parking

In agreement with Aberdeenshire Council, spaces will be fenced off within the existing community centre / pool car park for contractor parking only, commencing June 2018. Approximately 42 spaces at the community centre / pool car park (including disabled parking) will be retained for public use along with the newly created Victoria Park car parking facility.

## School engagement

We have already engaged with several local feeder schools and nurseries delivering a range of activities designed to give younger children an understanding of the project and site safety, and basic construction activities for older children.

Nominated pupils from each of the local schools have been invited to take part in the Robertson Reporters programme. The pupils will visit the site at key stages of the project to learn about the progress of the building work and report back to their respective schools.

## Inverurie Academy

We are continuing to work closely with Inverurie Academy to offer a variety of engaging activities for pupils. Our Trade Route programme, which focuses on S4 students interested in gaining an apprenticeship in a construction trade, commenced at the beginning of June. Over the course of the academic year we will deliver a range of classroom-based/site-based activities and presentations, and offer work experience with the aim of giving the young people valuable insight into working in the construction industry, and give them the best possible start in securing a trade apprenticeship – should this be of interest.

## Work experience placements

We welcomed our first work experience placement on site in May for four days. The work placement came from a nearby school as part of his fourth-year studies. He worked closely with our site team to gain an understanding of how a site operates and had the opportunity to help with the delivery and installation of our new site offices.

We will be working closely with Inverurie Academy, Aberdeenshire Council, Department of Work and Pensions (DWP), colleges and local employability providers to facilitate work experience placements throughout the duration of the project.

## Recycling

Over 99% of our total waste, which would have previously have gone to landfill, has been re-directed to be either reused or recycled.



We have registered with the Considerate Constructors Scheme, and you will see signage displayed around our site perimeter.

The aim of the scheme is to improve the image of construction; ensuring we minimise negative impact and integrate into the community during our time here.

We will be inspected during the duration of the project and scored on the following criteria:
