### Site updates

Since our last newsletter in October, we have continued making progress on the project and are happy to report the completion date remains on schedule.

The site team would like to take this opportunity to wish all our neighbours a prosperous New Year.

### Building works

Work on the structure of the main teaching building is now complete and we progressing with the installation of roofing and external cladding. This has allowed us to start our internal fit-out with plasterboard and blockwork partitions creating the form of the internal spaces. We expect to have the main teaching building fully enclosed by the end of March 2019.

## Charity

We were happy to support several charities during the run up to Christmas, including Light Up Children's Charity where we provided the items for their main raffle prize – a Christmas Hamper and hosting a Coffee and Cake morning on site raising over £100 for the Garioch Community Kitchen.

We also transformed a small shipping container into a Santa's Grotto in support of the We Are Inverurie Christmas activities. The Grotto was located in the town centre for 2 weeks at the beginning of December and was such a success that the team is now looking to keep the grotto on for future years.

## Inverurie Academy

We continue to work closely with Inverurie Academy to offer a variety of engaging activities for pupils.

We welcomed pupils from the media group onto site to produce a variety of short videos relating to the project, including the promotion of women in construction.

Our Trade Route programme for S4/S5 pupils continues to be a success. The pupils are now spending two afternoons a week on site working on building a hut and gaining some valuable work experience with a variety of trades.

- We recently switched over to mains supply for water and electricity.
- We have taken away 46.727 tonnes of waste from site, of which 99.71% has been re-directed to be either reused or recycled.
